1 General

- 1.1 The Coffs Harbour Bridge Club runs events at its premises on City Hill, Coffs Harbour.
- 1.2 Players must use the methods and equipment in the manner specified by the Director of the Day. Players must record the score for each board after it is played and before the commencement of the next board. It is an offence to leave the the table at the conclusion of a round or match without first confirming the completeness and validity of the data entered into the scoring unit. Every player at the table is equally responsible for the accuracy of the scores.
- 1.3 Smoking is not permitted in the Bridge Club building.
- 1.4 Mobile telephones, Ipads and other electronic communication equipment must be switched off during session time. Breach of this regulation may incur a disciplinary penalty, after one warning. (4.1)

2 Systems and Defences

- 2.1 GREEN, BLUE and RED systems and BROWN sticker conventions will be permitted in all sessions.

3 Seating

3.1 Seating will be determined by the Director of the Day

4 Disciplinary and Procedural Penalties

- 4.1 The Disciplinary Penalty relating to smoking and mobile phones is Average minus score 40% or -2 VPs in team events.
- 4.2 The General Provisions of ABF TR 10 concerning punctuality and slow play apply. The table of penalties is listed in the Appendices.
- 4.3 Any other Penalty is at the discretion of the Director.

5 Correction Period and Time for Requesting a Review

- 5.1 The Correction Period (Law 72C) allows 24 hours for score to be corrected after results posted on website. (Rules 30 minutes)
- 5.2 The time for requesting a review of a Directors Ruling (Law 92B)
Is 30 minutes after the results have been posted on the website.

6 Eligibility and Substitutions.

- 6.1 All players must individually meet the eligibility criteria to compete in certain events where required.
- 6.2 Substitutes: In events over two or more sessions (e.g. club championships): Pairs event One substitute of same or lower ranking for one session. Teams event; up to two players of same or lower ranking as replaced player or players for one session of the event.

7 Fouled Boards.

- 7.1 Scoring for a fouled board in pairs or teams will be determined by the Director
