

Directors Role at the Club:

The Director plays an important role in keeping the game fair, orderly and enjoyable for everyone.

All our Directors are volunteers and donate their time so you can enjoy your game of Bridge.

How can you as a player work with and help the Director?

1. Call the director Immediately if there is an irregularity at the table (revoke, hesitation, incorrect explanation, etc)
2. Treat the Director with courtesy and respect. Explain what happened clearly and honestly and let the Director ask any necessary questions.
3. Accept the ruling gracefully and continue play promptly so the movement or session is not delayed.
4. If you believe the ruling needs further discussion or is incorrect wait until the end of the session until raising it with the Director. Law 92B allows 30 minutes after the official score has been published to appeal the Directors decision. All requests and appeals must be made through the Director of the Day.

We all make mistakes and some of our decisions will be incorrect but please follow the Laws and appeal at the end of the session and we will do our best to correct it.

A cooperative attitude towards the Director helps maintain a friendly atmosphere and ensures that club bridge remains fair and enjoyable for everyone.
